# Operation Save-a-Life



#### Who should attend?

If you are concerned that a loved one is at risk for overdosing on a prescription pain medication or heroin, this training is for you!

#### What will you learn?

Participants will learn how to:

- <u>Recognize</u> opioid medications and the signs of an overdose,
- Respond to an overdose situation, and
- Revive a victim of opioid overdose by administering Naloxone (Narcan).

#### What is Naloxone?

Naloxone (Narcan) is a medication that reverses an opioid overdose. It cannot be used to get high and it is NOT addictive. Participants will receive one <u>free</u> dose at the end of the training.

Participants will receive a certificate card of completion accompanied by the tools and skills necessary to save a life in the event of an opioid overdose.
